Here is our curriculum overview for this half term.

As Athletes we will:

Develop our swimming skills.

As Authors we will:

Write a diary entry from the point of view of a character.

Write a letter in the role of an evacuee.

Write a discussion text.

As Scientists we will:

Find out about the use of mechanisms such as levers, gears and pulleys.

Identify forces and find out about Isaac Newton and his discoveries about gravity.

Look for patterns and links between the mass and weight of objects, using newton meters to measure the force of gravity.

Work collaboratively to investigate air and water resistance.

As Citizens we will:

Explore what to do in an accident or emergency.

As Historians we will:

Find out about evacuation.

Learn what it was like to live with food rationing. Explore the contribution made by women to the war effort.

Learn important facts about the Holocaust and investigate events that were key turning points in the war,

Research, discuss and classify different types of historical evidence.

As Linguists we will:

Develop our use of written and spoken French; working on our conversation skills.

Learn the vocabulary for our family members in French and be able to talk about them.



As Religious Investigators we will:

Explore Hinduism and think about what Hindus learn from stories about Krishna.
