As Citizens we will :

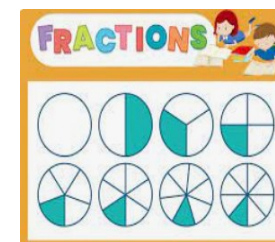
- * Learn about : *What makes a community?*
