### As Citizens we will:

### As musicians we will:

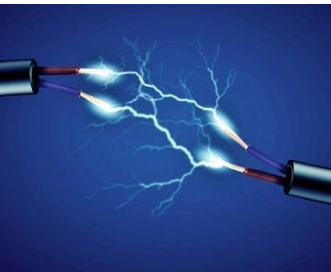
Play and perform brass instruments in solo and ensemble contexts. Appreciate and understand a wide range of music drawn from different traditions and great composers.
